

### Ways to help out at home

- The children know how to write using expanded noun phrases (adjective, adjective +noun) so you could ask them to write some for items around the house e.g. my untidy, cluttered bedroom. It is fun to compete for who can think of the most amazing adjective for a selected noun. You could keep a score.
- If they find a word they cannot spell ask them to clap the number of syllables (butterfly=bu/tter/fly). Once they know the number of syllables, can they write any of them? How does the word start/end? Where is the tricky part of the word?
- In maths you can practise telling the time- a very important life skill. The children need to know how to tell the time using hours, minutes and seconds. Also focus on money- see if your child can work out the total cost of some items and then tell you how much change they will get.
